NOTICE OF INCIDENT OF HARASSMENT AND INTIMIDATION

COMES NOW, Plaintiff CHRISTINA EVERETT, Pro Se, and hereby files this Notice of Incident of Harassment and Intimidation in relation to the above-referenced civil matter.

On or about July 28, 2025, Plaintiff received an unsolicited package at her official mailing address, which contained an obscene mechanical device designed to express a vulgar hand gesture. The package bore a sticker representing the 'Hawaii Republican Party' and was addressed directly to the Plaintiff.

Plaintiff believes the nature of the item and the use of political insignia raises significant concerns regarding intimidation, retaliation, and possible tampering or impersonation using federal postal services. A report was immediately filed with the Honolulu Police Department (HPD Report No. 25-297755) and an internal complaint was filed with the United States Postal Inspection Service requesting a formal investigation into the origin and intent of the delivery.

This filing is submitted for the Court's record to ensure Plaintiff's safety and good-faith participation in ongoing proceedings. No direct allegation is made against any named Defendant at this time; however, due to the timing of the incident during pending

litigation, Plaintiff respectfully asks the Court to take judicial notice of the incident and associated documentation.

Plaintiff reserves all rights under the law to pursue additional remedies or motions should future facts warrant.
